The appointee will be responsible to assist in the implementation and monitoring of research projects relating to physical activity in older adults. Duties include communication with the stakeholders involved, literature review, data collection (i.e., field tests), data analysis (i.e., SPSS), writing of academic reports/papers and any other related administrative work as required. The appointment will be for a period of around 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in Physical Education, Sports Science, Psychology or related field. Relevant research experience will be preferred. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent.

Applicants should have a good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese), as well as good communication skills and the ability to work independently under pressure.
