The appointment will be around 10 months with a possibility for renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a PhD in Ecology, Forestry or a cognate discipline. Experience in relevant research and journal publications in urban forestry is required. They should also be well-organized, have good interpersonal and communication skills, and can work independently and collectively in a team.
