The appointee will participate in a large-scale donation project aimed at enhancing primary school teachers' capacity in inquiry-based science education. The appointee will be responsible for undertake research-related duties and provide research support to the project in collaboration with the project advisor and project team;

- writing research and project proposals; conducting research activities including data collection and analysis;
- presenting findings in conferences, seminars, meetings, and knowledge transfer occasions;
- publishing of findings in high-quality peer-reviewed journals, books/chapters, and reports;
- performing any research/evaluation duties related to the project

Applicants should have a **PhD** / **Doctoral Degree** in Education, Science, or a related discipline with solid training in quantitative and qualitative research methods and knowledge in statistical analysis, as well as a very good publication track record. Applicants with working experience in primary/secondary education sectors in Hong Kong and experience in educational research are preferred, and working experience in assisting school-based support projects offered by tertiary institutions and teaching experience in primary/secondary schools will be an advantage. Applicants should have an excellent command of both written English and Chinese, and able to speak Putonghua and Cantonese. They should also be able to work independently, be good team players, have good interpersonal and communication skills, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, well-organized and able to work under pressure.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
