The Institute of Special Needs and Inclusive Education (ISNIE) is seeking a highly motivated and dedicated person to support the project planning and administration in the area of special education. The appointee will assist the Director for planning, coordinating and leading projects. He/She will be responsible for leading a team for project implementation, research activities, school liaison and support; and special needs training. The appointment will be for a period of 24 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should be with a Bachelor's Degree, preferably a Master's degree, in special education, educational psychology, psychological studies or related disciplines with at least 12 years or more of relevant post-qualification working experience including substantial experience in special education/ training for in-service and pre-service teachers, preferably gained in the education sectors. Applicants should preferably possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence. Applicants should also have high proficiency in both English and Chinese including Putonghua. Strong interpersonal, communication and organization skills, and literacy in computer applications are essential. Applicants with knowledge and working experience in managing education-related projects and in program implementation will be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 15% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits, and, where applicable, housing benefits.
