

Post-doctoral Fellow / Senior Research Assistant (Several Posts) (Ref: 2401007) Centre for Learning, Teaching and Technology

The appointee(s) will be responsible for providing research and coordination support for one of the following research projects in Artificial Intelligence (AI) in education:

(1) Promoting Personalized Learning in Elementary Mathematics through Collaboration between Teachers and Chatbots

(2) Multi-modal Handwriting Analysis Platform for Children

(3) Developing an AI Chinese Composition Assessment System for Hong Kong Students

Duties include conducting literature review, developing and validating research instruments and programs; conducting quantitative and qualitative data analysis; writing academic papers and reports, as well as performing other duties assigned by the project principal investigator. The appointment will be for a period of up to 24 months.

For the post of Post-doctoral Fellow, applicants should have a Doctoral Degree in Artificial Intelligence, Educational Technology, Computer Science, Engineering, Sensing Technology, Psychology, Occupational Technology and/or related disciplines, with strong statistical analysis ability.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a Master's Degree in the aforementioned disciplines, plus one-year post Master's degree full-time working experience, or a Doctoral Degree.

Applicants should have an excellent command of written English and Chinese, proficiency in spoken Cantonese, high capability of conducting statistical analysis, and writing academic papers and reports independently. A sound background in statistics and experience in using statistical packages such as SPSS and R, is advantageous. They should be self-motivated and able to work as a team member. Applicants with academic background and research experience in related fields would be preferable. Immediately available is preferred.
