Project Title: Digitalizing and gamifying corpus linguistics for virtual teaching and learning

[Appointment Period: around 6 months]

The appointee will participate in projects related to digitizing and gamifying corpus linguistics for teaching and learning. He/She will be mainly responsible for designing and creating a mobile app that contains information and games for learning corpus linguistics and tools for compiling corpora. He/She will also be involved in a wide range of research activities, such as reviewing literature, collecting and analyzing data, preparing research reports, and undertaking project-related administrative work. The appointment will be for a period of 6 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants for Research Assistant I should have a Bachelor's Degree or above in Computational Linguistics, Computer Science, Language Technology or a related discipline, with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience, or an approved qualification or equivalent standard. Applicants should have a good command of spoken and written English and Chinese, and being familiar with corpus linguistics and discourse analysis is desirable.

Applicants for Research Assistant II should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preference will be given to applicants with a Bachelor's degree or above in Computer Science, Data Science or related fields.
