There will be opportunities for manuscript writing and publications in international journals. The appointment will be for around 3 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have (i) a Bachelor's degree or above, preferably in the areas of Public Administration, Political Science, or a related field of social sciences; (ii) Experience in quantitative research methods; (iii) Excellent interpersonal and communication skills; (iv) Proficiency in both written English.
