Project Title: Investigation of the Homo- and Hetero-aggregation of Nanoplastics Driven by Rhizosphere Components and Implications for Rice Uptake [Appointment Period: 12 months]

The appointee will assist the project investigator in rice and nanoplastics related research. The primary duties include reviewing the literature, conducting both lab and fieldwork, and performing extensive data analysis and scientific writing for publication. They will also be responsible for drafting reports and proposals for submission and performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for around 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

The position of Research Assistant requires a Bachelor's degree. Preference will be given to candidates with good knowledge of agriculture and environmental pollution related research, rich experience in fieldwork, and the ability to work independently with minimal direct supervision. They should also be a good team player, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and able to work under pressure. Immediate availability is preferred.
