Project Title: Ageing Playfully: Public Spaces, Playfulness, and Well-being for Older Adults in Densely Populated Cities/ field survey, behaviour data collection and analysis, interview data collection and analysis

The appointee will be responsible for supporting dynamic research projects. Key responsibilities include:

- 1. Qualitative research skills: Proficiency in interview techniques and data analysis using software like NVivo for planning and executing research tasks.
- 2. Spatial analysis competence: Expertise in spatial data acquisition and analysis, including proficiency in SketchUp, AutoCAD, and ArcGIS Pro for data entry, visualization, and analysis of physical and management characteristics of public open spaces.
- 3. Project management: Ability to assist the PI in coordinating study participants, stakeholders, and student helpers, including recruitment, scheduling, and training.
- 4. Data collection and analysis: Conduct field observations, document public open spaces, perform user-mapping, and assist in data entry, coding, and analysis.

Qualifications for the RA position include:

- Bachelor's degree, preferably Master's degree or higher in geography, urban design and planning, urban studies
- Minimum 2 years of qualitative research experience
- Proficiency in NVivo (or equivalent), ArcGIS Pro, AutoCAD, and Adobe Suite
- Experience with Python for data analysis, automation, or spatial data processing is highly desirable.
- Language skills: Fluency in Cantonese, Mandarin, and English

The appointment will be for a period of 6 months with possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.
