The appointee should have a strong understanding of local primary school curricula and educational practices, along with proficiency in qualitative and quantitative analysis. Relevant experience, such as primary school teaching or teaching material development, is preferred. Responsibilities include assisting with research projects, preparing teaching materials, and collaborating with faculty to enhance educational pedagogy.

Applicants should have a Bachelor 's degree in Social Science or related disciplines. Experience and skills in analyses of survey and interview data would be an advantage. Good command in both spoken and written English and Chinese (Cantonese and Putonghua) and with good communicative skills are essential. The appointee will also be occasionally required to perform duties in non-regular hours.
