Project Title: A novel conditioning approach to counter loneliness in adults

[Appointment Period: 6 months]

The appointee will support research projects investigating the effects of neuro-behavioural training on loneliness, depression symptoms, and socio-affective processing. He/she will be engaged in all stages of the research process. The appointee will be responsible for developing research materials, conducting literature review, assisting in the coordination and administrative work of the projects, supporting behavioural and neuroimaging (e.g., MRI) data collection, data analysis, writing manuscripts/reports, and performing any other duties as assigned. He/she may have to travel to other institutions.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology, Cognitive neuroscience, or a related discipline, preferably with some research experience. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. They should also have a good command of written Chinese and English, a good command of Cantonese, as well as be conversant in English; have good interpersonal skills and organisational skills. Knowledge of and experience in cognitive neuroscience and psychology, especially in research methods, neuroimaging, and programming will be a definite advantage.
