**Project Title: Enhancing Teaching and Learning of Chinese Reading in Primary Schools**

**[Appointment Period: 12 months]**

Starting from August 2025, the Education University of Hong Kong will be launching a territory-wide project, cooperating with around 60 primary schools in response to the need to enhance high order reading skills (高階閱讀能力) for primary students in Hong Kong. The project aims to produce animations, design innovative learning and teaching activities, and develop other multimedia learning materials that emphasize interactions.

The appointee will be required to collect, sort, and analyse information or research materials for the project, compile statistical data, and perform other duties as assigned. The appointees will be expected to commence employment around August 2025.

Applicants for Research Assistant I should have a Bachelor's Degree preferably in Education, Statistics, Psychology or related disciplines. They should possess excellent command of English and Chinese (including Cantonese), and strong computer skills. Basic AI skills and knowledge are preferred.

Applicants for Research Assistant II should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent.

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Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
