The appointee will be responsible for assisting in the implementation and monitoring of research projects related to outdoor adventure, mental health and wellness. He/she should be familiar with outdoor activities and psychology theories, as well as advanced research methods and data analysis (i.e., SEM, CFA, matlab). Additionally, the appointee will be expected to write academic reports/papers, do out of office data collection, and any other related administrative work as required. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably a Master's Degree, or a Doctorate in Physical Education, Sports Science, Psychology, or related fields. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent.

Applicants should have a good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese), as well as good communication skills and the ability to work independently, as well as collaborative under pressure.
