## [Appointment Period: around 9 months]

The appointee will be responsible for providing research and administrative support to the project team. She/he will participate in research design, developing learning and teaching packages and other research materials, overseeing project progress, drafting project-related reports, coordinating project-related publications and dissemination, and performing any other duties as assigned. During the project, the appointee will work closely with teachers in the participating schools, including co-planning lessons and providing professional advice on the teaching and assessment of teachers. The appointment will be for a period of around 9 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in Chinese language, Education, or a related discipline with at least 3 years post-qualification full-time working experience, preferably in tertiary institutions. Applicants with extensive front-line teaching experience and a strong familiarity with Chinese language curricula and teaching are preferred. Applicants who have a Master's degree or higher in Chinese language, Education, or a related discipline, with 5 or more years of teaching or academic research experience would be an advantage; Preference will be given to candidates with experience in developing school-based Chinese curricula, observing and co-planning lessons, and coordinating large-scale educational research.
