The appointee will participate in a large-scale donation project aimed at studying students' science identity and science learning. The appointee will be responsible for undertake research-related duties and provide research support to international collaboration research project with the project advisors and project team;

- assist in writing research and project proposals; conducting research activities including data collection and analysis;
- contribute to the preparation of reports, seminars, meetings, and knowledge transfer occasions;
- aid in the dissemination of findings in high-quality peer-reviewed journals, books/chapters, and reports; and
- support other research/evaluation duties related to the project

The appointment will be for a period of around **24 months**, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Degree in Education, Science, or a related discipline with understanding of research methods and data analysis techniques. Applicants with working experience in primary/secondary education sectors in Hong Kong and experience in educational research are preferred, and working experience in assisting school-based support projects offered by tertiary institutions and teaching experience in primary/secondary schools will be an advantage. Applicants should have a good command of both written English and Chinese, and able to speak Putonghua and Cantonese. They should also be able to work independently, be good team players, have good interpersonal and communication skills, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, well-organized and able to work under pressure.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
