Project Title: Investigating Teacher Evaluative Judgement in an AI-mediated Assessment Landscape: A Phenomenographic Study

The appointee will be responsible for conducting literature reviews, assisting in the research data collection and analysis process, facilitating the promotion of research findings (e.g., infographics design), writing research reports and other duties assigned by the Principal Investigator. The initial appointment will be for a period of 12 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably with a Master's Degree, in education-related disciplines. Prior experience in conducting qualitative research will be valued. He/She is expected to possess good English writing skills, be attentive to details, and demonstrate strong self-motivation and responsibility in task completion.

The principal investigator welcomes applicants who have plans to pursue doctoral studies with her to apply for this post, particularly those interested in or have experience in the below areas: (1) how emerging technologies, particularly generative AI, impact the ethical, relational and affective dimensions of educational assessment, (2) the governance/regulation of these technologies through education policies at different levels (mainly at higher education level), and (3) the issue around student cheating and academic integrity in the digital age with her.
