[Appointment period: 12 months]

The appointee will assist the project investigator in coordinating research projects on assessing biogeochemical processes in environmental microbiome. The primary duties include reviewing the literature, performing data analysis, and preparing manuscripts for publication. They will also be responsible for drafting reports and proposals for submission and performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for around 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably with a Bachelor's Degree or above with relevant research experience in (1) bioinformatics (e.g., (meta)genomics) and (2) biology/environmental microbiology/chemistry is preferred. Preference will also be given to applicants with the above research experience, and the ability to work independently with minimal direct supervision. They should also be a good team player, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and able to work under pressure. Immediate availability is preferred.
