The appointee will be working as a full-time Research Assistant I to support the project "Advancing a global academic hub for Chinese language teaching and learning: Development of *International Journal of Chinese Language Education (IJCLE)* in 2025-2028". The appointment will be for a period of 12 months starting from January 2026. Renewal of contract for another 12 – 24 months is possible, subject to performance review.

The successful applicant will provide academic and administrative support to the project. Responsibilities mainly include: (i) assistance with editing of *IJCLE*; (ii) conduct of research activities relevant to the project; (iii) promotion of *IJCLE* via different channels and liaison with different stakeholders to increase the visibility of the journal's brand; (iv) assistance with academic event/ conference organizing; and (v) any other duties assigned by the project PI and the Editors-in-Chief of *IJCLE*.

Applicants should have a bachelor's degree (preferably a master's degree) in language education, second/ foreign language acquisition, applied linguistics, or related fields. Applicants with several years of relevant post-qualification working experience gained in the tertiary education sector are preferable. They should have an excellent command of both written English and Chinese; proficiency in spoken English, Putonghua and Cantonese is preferred. They should also be self-motivated, well-organized, have good interpersonal and communication skills, be able to work independently and collectively as a good team member and have the ability to work under pressure.
