

Post-doctoral Fellow (Ref: 2501214) Graduate School

The appointee will be responsible for supporting research projects, programme development, and conference organisation. He/she will assist in searching and reviewing literature, analysing survey and interview data, writing the reports, managing administrative work, supervising other research assistants and doctoral students, and performing other duties as assigned by the project leader. The initial appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a doctoral degree in Education, Psychology, learning science, neuroscience, or other relevant subjects. Past experience of using advanced qualitative and quantitative research software (e.g., Mplus, R, PLS) is also preferred. Applicants should be proficient in both written and spoken English, Cantonese, and Mandarin, self-motivated, and willing to learn to handle unfamiliar tasks. Capacity in performing Neuroscience methods (e.g., fMRI, EEG, and fNIRS) and big data techniques (e.g., machine/deep learning) will be an advantage. Shortlisted candidates may be invited to sit for a written test.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
