The appointee will be responsible for supporting research projects. He/she will assist in searching and reviewing literature, analyzing quantitative and qualitative data, writing the reports, managing administrative work, supervising other research assistants and student helpers, and performing other duties as assigned by the project leader. The initial appointment will be for a period of 6 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should hold a doctoral degree, preferably in Education, Psychology, Statistics or other relevant subjects and have at least two first-author quantitative publications in top journals. Candidates who are proficient in using advanced qualitative and quantitative research software (e.g., Mplus, R, PLS, Nvivo, SPSS) are also preferable. Applicants should be proficient in both written and spoken English and Chinese, self - motivated, and willing to learn to handle unfamiliar tasks. Shortlisted candidates may be invited to sit for a written test.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
