Specific duties will involve: 1) Developing and implementing advanced Artificial Intelligence (AI) solutions to meet the project's objectives and performance requirements; 2) Integrating advanced psychological paradigms and validated theoretical frameworks into Large Language Models (LLMs) to achieve the project needs. The appointment will be for a period of 8 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should hold a Master's degree in a related discipline, plus at least one year of full-time post-master's work experience, or a doctoral degree.

For the post of Research Assistant I, Applicant should have a Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Artificial Intelligence, or a related discipline with relevant post-qualification working experience. The applicant should be self-motivated, able to work independently and with good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese.
