The appointee will perform other duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. Working off-campus may be required. The appointment will be for around six months.

Applicants should have a recognized University degree, preferably a master's degree in Art, Design or related discipline, with at least 7 years of post-qualification work experience. Managerial experience in Art or Exhibition is an advantage. The applicants should demonstrate leadership and coordination skills to design and manage projects in team settings, experience in staff supervision, conflict resolution. High proficiency in written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese and Putonghua), attentive to details, highly self-motivated and have strong communication and organisation skills are required.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
