**Project Title: Conceptualizing, Investigating, and Cultivating Teachers’  
Generative Artificial Intelligence Competency**  
**[Appointment Period: 12 months]**

This project examines how teachers develop Generative AI competency through structured professional development. It involves designing training resources, implementing school-based teacher learning activities, and conducting empirical research on teachers’ AI-related knowledge, practices, attitudes, and professional learning processes.

The appointee will liaise with local primary and secondary schools and coordinate teacher training activities; support the organisation and implementation of professional development programmes for teachers and assist in data collection, management, and basic analysis; contribute to research-related tasks, including literature review and report writing; collaborate with the project team to support video development and related project outputs; and undertake other duties as assigned.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects, including Chinese Language, English Language, and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects, including Chinese, English (Syllabus B), and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent; A Master’s degree in Education or a related discipline will be an advantage. They should have some experience in educational research or related project work; Teaching experience in core subjects (e.g., Chinese, English, Mathematics, Science); Strong interest in AI in education with demonstrated initiative in exploring and experimenting with emerging AI tools; a proactive attitude and the ability to work independently in a fast-paced project environment and strong organisational and communication skills. A good command of written English is preferred (e.g. an overall IELTS score of 6.5 or above, with a minimum of 6.5 in the writing component, or equivalent). Proficiency in Cantonese would be an advantage for school liaison.
