The appointee will engage in teaching, administrative duties, and other services. Applicants should have a doctoral degree in a relevant discipline with substantial post-qualification teaching experience in a tertiary education setting. Preference will be given to those possessing qualified teacher status and/or relevant professional qualifications, with strong understanding of the educational context of Hong Kong and/or the Greater Bay Area. Applicants should be fluent in English; knowledge of Cantonese and/or Putonghua will be an advantage.
