Project Title: Developing an Integrated Chatbot System for Enhancing Social Interaction Skills and Global Perspectives

[Appointment Period: 6 months]

The appointee will participate in a research and development project focused on Artificial Intelligence Generated Content (AIGC) for enhancing students' social interaction skills and global perspectives. He/she will be responsible for

- studying the requirements of leveraging generative artificial intelligence to empower teaching and learning;
- developing algorithms of artificial intelligence generated content and chatbot to improve students' social interaction skills and global perspectives;
- deploying the developed prototype, conducting the cross-institution study, and delivering workshops to students; and
- performing any other duties as assigned by Principal Investigator or his delegates.

There will be opportunities for report writing and publications in international journals or conferences. The initial appointment will be for 6 months, with a renewal opportunity subject to the appointee's performance.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects, including Chinese Language, English Language, and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects, including Chinese, English (Syllabus B), and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent; A Bachelor's Degree or above in Data Science, Information Technology, Artificial Intelligence, Educational Technology, or Education-related disciplines with expertise in artificial intelligence and EdTech project experience will be an advantage. They should have hands-on experience in programming and background knowledge in generative artificial intelligence. In addition, the applicants should have good communication skills in both written and spoken English and Chinese, as well as good interpersonal and communication skills. They should be mature and able to work independently. Preference will be given to those with research and/or project development experience.
