The appointee will be responsible for supporting research and other related tasks of conducting the Hong Kong leg of this international research project. The appointee will be based in Hong Kong. The appointment will initially be for a period of twelve months.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree plus one year's post Master's degree full-time working experience, or a Doctorate degree in higher education policy. He/She should be interested in researching higher education policy in Hong Kong. Required skills include conducting literature reviews, an understanding of quantitative data analysis, an understanding of qualitative research methods, and excellent organisational and interpersonal skills. We seek a candidate who can work independently and in a team, and who has a good command of written and spoken English.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
